Bottari is an Italian, the eighth of nine children born in Palermo (Sicily) on the 29th August 1949.

He was the pupil (for the paintings on ceramics in Albissola) of WIFREDO LAM, the Chinese – Cuban friend of PICASSO.

Lorenzo also has studied with some of the greatest exponents of contemporary art including CORRADO CAGLI, GIORGIO de CHIRICO, RENATO GUTTUSO, IBRAHIM KODRA and many others.

In 1968 he is moved in Florence and then he lived for many years in England, Germany, France and Switzerland where he painted and furthered his career. Bottari has shown in numerous one man and collective exhibitions in New York, Paris, Milan, Stockholm, Copenhagen and many others.

He has had outstanding success working in ceramics and silver.

Lorenzo has executed a series of thirty pieces in gold inlaid with precious stones.
